This Criminal Petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.'), is filed by the petitioner – accused No.4 to quash the proceedings against him in C.C.No.285 of 2015 on the file of learned IV Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate at Hyderabad, registered for the offences under Sections 420, 409, 406 read with, 477-A read with 34 of Indian Penal Code (for short 'I.P.C').

2. None appears for the petitioner. Perused the record.

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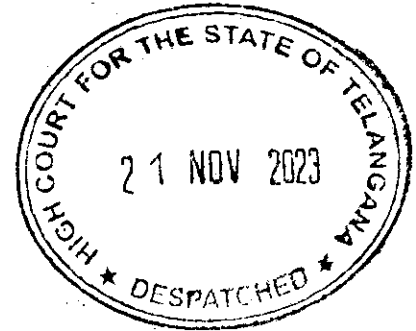
