Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ order or direction declaring the action of the respondent No.5 authority in coming to the petty shop of the petitioner running in an extent of 70 square yards in survey number 2394 situated near to the Bus-Stand of the Huzurabad Village and Mandal, Karimnagar District and informing the petitioner that, he is going to demolish the same when the proposals for alienation of the said extent of land is sent by the authorities themselves and awaiting appropriate orders from the higher authorities, is nothing but arbitrary, illegal, null and void and violative of Articles 14, 19 and 21 of the Constitution of India. Consequently direct the respondent no.5 not to demolish the petty shop and shed of the petitioner running in an extent of 156 square yards in survey number 2394 situated near to the Bus-Stand of the Huzurabad Village and Mandal, Karimnagar District until final orders issued by the respondents no.1 to 4, there by direct the respondents no.1 to 3 issue

appropriate orders for execution of appropriate document in favour of the petitioner alienating the said extent of land basing on the proposals sent by the respondents no.3 to 5.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent no.5 not to dispossess and dismantle the shop and shed constructed by the petitioner in an extent of 156 square yards in survey number 2394 situated near to the Bus-Stand of the Huzurabad Village and Mandal, Karimnagar District, where the petitioner is doing his petty business.

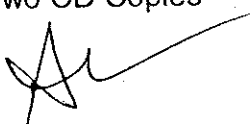

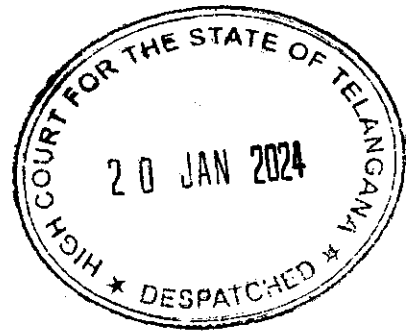
