ORDER:

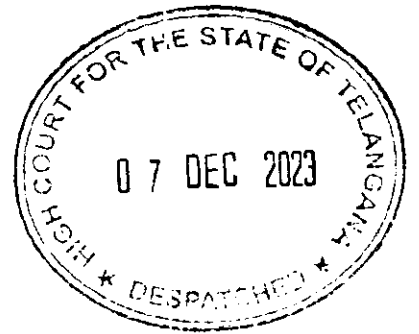
