Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus - declaring the action of the respondents 1 to 3 in disconnecting the power supply to the SC. No. M2-97230 of the petitioners house basing on the purported representation (referred to in the letter Dt. 11.6.2014 of the 1st respondent) and pending consideration of the reply/representation issued in the form of legal notice dt.13.6.2014 as arbitrary, illegal and contrary to the statutory duties besides being in dereliction of powers and principles of natural justice and consequently direct the respondents to restore the power supply to SC. No.M2-97230 of the petitioner's house bearing D.No.3-5-208/2, Kotagally Nizamabad Town and Dist. and also to pay her the damages for causation of indefinable hardship to her family in the interest of justice.
