ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioners who are arrayed as Accused Nos.1 and 2 seeking to quash the proceedings against them in FIR No.365 of 2020 on the file of Station House Officer, Kodad Town Police Station, Suryapet District.

2. On written instructions, learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that after completion of investigation in the subject crime, the police filed charge sheet before the Court concerned and C.C.No.231 of 2022 was assigned.
