Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more in the nature of Writ of Mandamus by declaring the action of the 2nd respondent in not including the name of the school for admissions into the general nursing and midwifery training course issued in R.C.No.28722/NI/2020 dt.05.09.2020 even though the petitioner has valid permission of the Government for the school arbitrary, illegal and untenable in law and consequently direct the 2nd respondent to allow the school to function normally and allow the school to take admissions of students for general nursing and midwifery training course for the academic year 2020-2021 and by setting aside the order of the 4th respondent bearing No. TSNMC/GNM/5130/2020 declaring the same to be without jurisdiction and illegal and opposed to the principles of natural justice.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the order of the 4th respondent bearing No. TSNMC/GNM/5130/2020 and direct the 2nd respondent to include the petitioner school for admission to general nursing and midwifery training course without insisting for the recognition of the Nursing Council forthwith as otherwise the petitioners would be put to irreparable loss grave suffering.
