Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ or Order or Orders, Direction or Directions to direct the respondents not to proceed in any manner to fill-up the post of District Panchayat Officer by way of direct recruitment in pursuance to a Notification No.18/2011, dated 28.11.2011 as the same is illegal, arbitrary and violative of Article 16 of the Constitution of India and for a consequential direction to direct the respondents to fill-up the said posts by way of promotion from the eligible Divisional Panchayat Officers.

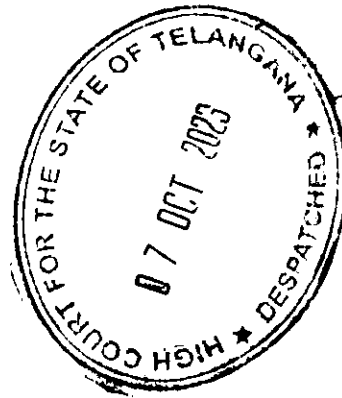
