Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the criminal proceedings in Crime No.200/2022 of PS Vemulawada (T), Rajanna Sircilla District, for the alleged offence U/Sec.354, 506 IPC against the Petitioner/Accused.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri V RAGHUNATH , Advocate for the Petitioner and the Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and of Sri Penuballi Ramesh Babu, Advocate for the Respondent No.2.

The Court made the following: ORDER

CRIMINAL PETITION No.4607 OF 2022

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioner/Accused to quash the proceedings against him in Crime No.200 of 2022 on the file of Vemulawada Town Police Station, Rajanna Sircilla District for the offences under Section 354, 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent – State. Perused the record.

3. The 2nd respondent filed a complaint stating that on 20.03.2022, the petitioner allegedly trespassed into her house and behaved indecently.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that he is a practicing advocate and the 2nd respondent is a client, however false complaint is made with a delay of nearly fifty days.

5. Since there is delay of 50 days in lodging the complaint, and no reasons are given as to why such delay occurred, this Court

deems it appropriate to direct the Police to conclude the investigation without taking any coercive steps against the petitioner. However, the petitioner shall appear for the purpose of investigation as and when required.

6. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed off.

Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
