ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by the petitioner seeking to direct the respondent i.e., Station House Officer, Devanpally Police Station, Kamareddy, to register a case basing on the private complaint filed by the petitioner under Section 200 Cr.P.C. vide CrI.M.P.No.292 of 2023 on the file of learned Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, (Special Mobile) at Kamareddy, which was referred by the learned Magistrate under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C., and cause investigation and file final report before the learned Magistrate Court within four weeks.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri S. Ganesh, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for respondent-State.

3. Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submitted written instructions submitted by the Station House Officer, Devanpally Police Station, wherein, it is stated that pursuant to the complaint of the petitioner, a case has been registered vide F.I.R.No.252 of 2023 on 20.07.2023. Therefore, the prayer sought for in the criminal petition has become infructuous.

4. In view of the above, the Criminal Petition is dismissed as infructuous.
