ORDER:

The petitioner approached this Court seeking the relief as under:

"To issue a Writ order or direction and more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents in not conducting instant examination for allowing the Petitioner to complete and clear the backlog subject and in further not allowing the Petitioner to attend the counseling for admission into engineering college on 28.06.2014 as illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional and consequently, direct the respondents to conduct the examination and allow the petitioner to attend the counseling session scheduled to take place on 28.06.2014 and pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deems fit just and proper in the circumstances of the case."

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner brings to the notice of this Court that the cause of action in the present Writ Petition does not survive for adjudication any more.

3. Bringing the said submission on record, this Writ Petition is dismissed as infructuous. Interim order granted

earlier on 27.06.2014 shall stand vacated. However, there shall be no order as to costs.

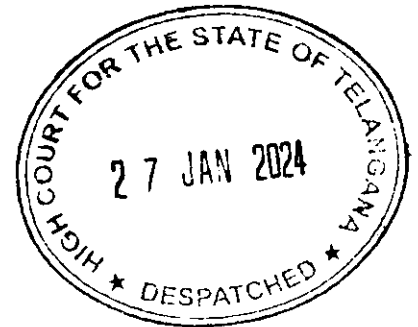
