Petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to release the Petitioners/accused on bail in the event of their arrest in connection with Cr.No. 6 of 2023 dt 13/01/2023 on the file of Tripuraram Police Station, Nalgonda Dist .

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri MULLANGI RAMI REDDY, (17203) Advocate for the Petitioner and Public Prosecutor for the State of Telangana on behalf of the Respondent.

The Court made the following: ORDER

THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE K.SURENDER**CRIMINAL PETITION No.7161 OF 2023****ORDER:**

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner who is arrayed as accused No.1 in the event of his arrest in Crime No.6 of 2023 pending on the file of Station House Officer, Tripuraram Police Station, Nalgonda District, filed for the offences punishable under Sections 384, 427 and 341 of Indian Penal Code.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent-State. Perused the record.

3. Since the punishment prescribed for the offences alleged against the petitioner are punishable up to seven (7) years, without going into the merits of the case, the respondent-Police are directed to carry out the investigation by strictly following the procedure as contemplated under Section 41-A Cr.P.C and the guidelines formulated by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Arnesh Kumar v.***

State of Bihar¹scrupulously. It is needless to say, any deviation in this regard will be viewed seriously. The petitioner shall co-operate with the Investigating Officer in concluding the investigation.

4. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed off.

Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, in this criminal petition, shall stand closed.

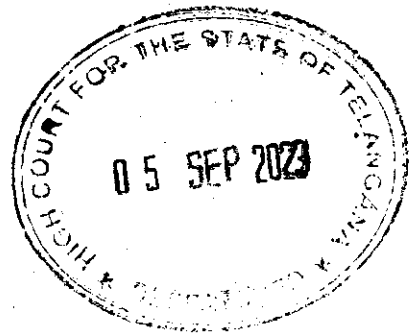
