Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the 4th respondent in his proceedings Rc.No.A/20/2017, Dt. 17.02.2017 as illegal, arbitrary and against the principles of natural justice and consequently direct the 4th respondent to restore the land to the petitioners as per the title deeds and pattadar pass books of individuals and give possession to the petitioners over the lands for extent of Ac.6.20 cents in Sy.No.73/1 and Ac. 1.00 cents in Sy.No.31/2 situated at Kasinagaram Village, Dommagudem Mandal, Bhadradi Kothagudem District.
