Yds, as illegal, unjust, arbitrary, high- handed, and consequently, direct the respondents not to interfere/dispossess the petitioner from his Plot admeasuring 150 Sq. Yds, in Block No. 19, in Sy. No. 79/11 situated at Narsapur Municipality, Narsapur Mandal, Medak District, except under due process of law.
