Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order of direction, preferably one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus and to declare the impugned proceedings in Govt. Memo No.3680/A/A1/2021, dt. 24-6-2022 of the 1st respondent by rejecting the case of the petitioner for appointment under compassionate grounds without examining the any of the proposals forwarded by the respondents No.2 to 4 and simply rejected the case of the petitioner without any application of mind, the said action of the respondents is highly illegal arbitrary, unreasonable, discriminatory and also in violation of principles of natural justice and without any application of mind and also in violation of Art. 14, 16 and 21 of the Constitution of India and declare the same as bad-in-law and set aside the same and consequently direct

the respondents to consider the case the petitioner for appointment in any suitable post under compassionate grounds under provisions of Hindu Adoption and Maintenance Act 1956.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the impugned Govt.
