ORDER:

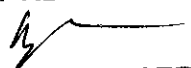
Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is no more, hence, the cause in this Criminal Petition does not survive for adjudication.

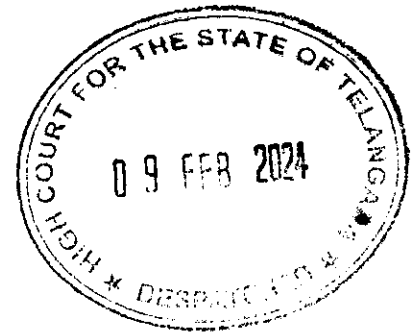
