Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ or order or direction more specifically in the nature of a writ of mandamus declaring the action of the Mandal Revenue Officer, the 2nd Respondent herein in not taking action for mutating petitioners name as owner and possessor of the agricultural land to an extent of Ac.7.06 Gts. situated in Survey No.502, Gudimalla Revenue Village, Khammam (Rural Mandal) by not amending the record of rights showing the Petitioner herein as the Pattadar of the said land despite making representations dated 17-10-2019, 03-05-2021 and 14-06-2021 to the 2nd Respondent herein as arbitrary, illegal, unjust, contrary to Law and contrary to contrary to the Telangana Right to Land and Pattadar Passbook Act 2020, and in violation of the Petitioners fundamental rights guaranteed under Article 14, 19 and 21 of the Constitution of India and Constitutional Guarantee enshrined under Article 300-A, and consequently be pleased to direct the 2nd Respondent herein to mutate the name of the Petitioner in the ROR Record and

issue Pattadar Pass Book by entering the name of the Petitioners name as the Owner and possessor of agricultural Land to an extent of Ac.7-06Gts. in Survey No.502, Gudimalla Revenue Village, Khammam (Rural Mandal), Telangana State.

**IA NO: 2 OF 2021**

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to permit the petitioner to implead proposed 3rd Respondent as party/ 3rd Respondent to the main Writ Petition No. 24901/2021 and also in the pending Interlocutory Applications therein.

**IA NO: 1 OF 2021**

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 2nd Respondent herein to issue Pattadar Passbook forthwith to the Petitioner herein with respect to his land to the extent of Ac.7-06Gts. situated in Gudimalli Village, Khammam (Rural Mandal), Khammam District.

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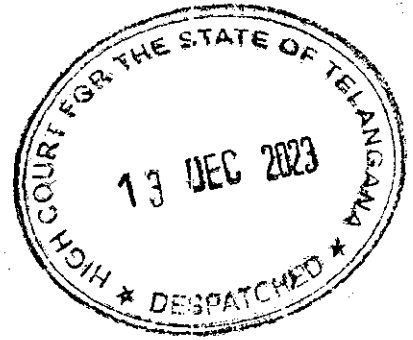
