JUDGMENT:

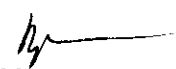
When the matter has been taken up for hearing, learned counsel for the appellant submitted that this matter has become infructuous.

As a sequel, pending Miscellaneous Applications, if any, shall stand closed.

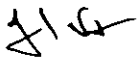
