This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri ARUN KUMAR DODDLA, Advocate for the Petitioner being not present and the Public Prosecutor (TG/AP) on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and Sri.P. HARI PRASAD REDDY for the Respondent No.2 and 3.

The Court made the following: ORDER

CRIMINAL PETITION No.6067 of 2018

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition, under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, is filed by the petitioner-husband seeking to quash the impugned order, dated 31.03.2018 passed in CrI.M.P.No.1795 of 2016 in M.C.No.268 of 2016 by the Additional Metropolitan Sessions Judge for the Trial of JHCBBC-cum-Additional Family Court, Hyderabad, whereby the Court below was pleased to grant interim maintenance in favour of the respondent Nos.2 and 3 i.e., wife and daughter of the petitioner-husband, at the rate of Rs.7,000/- and Rs.2,000/- per month respectively, from the date of petition i.e., 23.05.2016 till the disposal of the main M.C.

2. None appears for the petitioner.

3. As seen from the record, no interim orders are passed suspending the impugned order, dated 31.03.2018. Since interim maintenance is questioned, at this length of time, it is unlikely that the subject M.C. is still pending. Further, no proof is filed by the petitioner with regard to the payment of Rs.2,50,000/- as directed by this Court. Therefore, this Court do not find any reason to keep the criminal petition pending.

4. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court, if cause survives.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending in this criminal petition, shall stand closed.

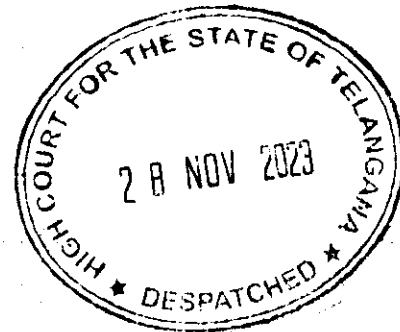
