This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri K.V.RAJASREE, Advocate for the Petitioner and the Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and None Appeared for the Respondent No.2

The Court made the following: ORDER

THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE K.SURENDER

CRIMINAL PETITION No.6640 of 2019

ORDER:

1. This Criminal Petition is filed to quash the proceedings against the petitioner/A1 in Crime No.436 of 2019 of P.S.Begumpet, Hyderabad for the offences under Sections 448 & 379 of IPC.
2. Briefly, the facts of the case are that the petitioner is the tenant of the 2nd respondent wife's property. Disputes arose in between them and they have approached the Court. The petitioner was asked to vacate the premises.
3. The 2nd respondent filed complaint stating that the property was subjected to theft by this petitioner. At the same time, the petitioner also filed complaint alleging theft of his articles/material.
4. Admittedly, disputes in between the petitioner and the 2nd respondent, one alleging theft committed by the other. The theft complaints are entertained and two crimes are registered. The petitioner's complaint was registered as Crime No.435 of 2019 and 2nd respondent's complaint was registered as Crime No.436 of 2019.

5. In the said situation, the allegations made against one another of theft, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the police to conclude investigation taking into consideration the representation of both parties. Further, the police are directed not to take any coercive steps against the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed off. Consequently, miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.
