2. Heard Mr. Anand, learned counsel representing Mr. P. Nagendra Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Vizarith Ali, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor appearing for respondent State.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit the C.C.No.129 of 2014 before the trial Court has been transferred to some other Court.
