ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioner/accused No.1 to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.180 of 2017 on the file of the XII Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Hyderabad, registered for the offences against accused are punishable under Sections 406 and 420 of Indian Penal Code.

2. Heard learned counsel for the respondent No.1-State and perused the record.
3. None appeared on behalf of the petitioner. This Court by order, dated 23.10.2019, directed personal notice to be served on respondent No.2. No memo is filed with proof of service of notice. In the said circumstances, this Court is not inclined to keep the Criminal Petition pending.

4. Accordingly, this Criminal Petition is disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court, in the event of cause surviving.

Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, in this criminal petition, shall stand closed.

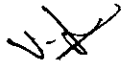
