Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ Order or direction, more particularly, one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the impugned action of the respondents in not awarding '10' spouse points to the petitioner as per Rule 6 c of the Telangana Teachers (Regulation of Transfers) Rules, 2018, is illegal, arbitrary, discriminatory, against Rule 6c of the Transfer Rules, 2018 and violation of Articles 14 and 16 of the constitution of India and consequently hold that the petitioner is entitled for '10' spouse points in ensuing transfer counseling, 2018 with all consequential benefits.
