ORDER:

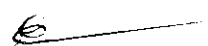
Learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that cause in the criminal petition does not survive for adjudication.

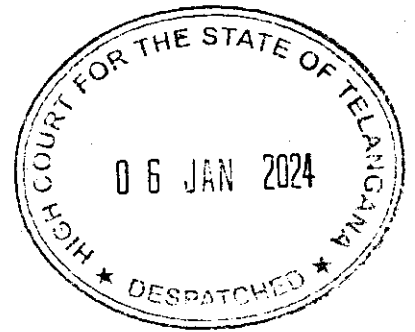
