This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioner/accused No.1 to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.390 of 2015, pending on the file of the learned I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Warangal, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498-A, 323, 506 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 3 and 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the respondent-State and perused the record.
3. As seen from the proceeding sheet, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on 06.11.2023 though the case was listed at the request of learned counsel for the petitioner vide letter, dated 28.08.2023. Today also
