Petition Under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS, declaring the action of the respondents in threatening to dispossess the petitioners from their respective peaceful possession and

enjoyment of the lands to an extent of Ac. 7-12 cents in Sy.No.88 situated at Chakirala Village, Nadigudem Mandal, Nalgonda district without following due process of law is illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional and contrary to law and being violative of Article 14, 16, 21 and 300A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioners by issuing pattadar pass books in the names of the petitioners respectively in an extent of Ac. 7-12 cents in Sy.No. 88 situated at Chakirala Village, Nadigudem Mandal, Nalgonda district.
