CRIMINAL PETITION No.181 of 2015

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed aggrieved by the Order dated 07.07.2014 in CRP No.4 of 2014 on the file of learned VI Additional Sessions Judge-(III FTC) Warangal at Mahabubabad by confirming the Order dated 12.11.2013 in CrI.M.P.No.5778 of 2010 in M.C.No.31 of 1993 on the file of learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Narsampet, wherein this petition is allowed by enhancing the maintenance amount of Rs.200/- to Rs.3000/- per month.
