Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents in adopting clandestine manner in the selection process for appointment to the post of Junior Assistant cum Typist in pursuance of notification issued in Advt. No. 2/Services III Section/2010, dt. 27th September, 2010 in so far as Zone VII is concerned as illegal, arbitrary, contrary to proceedings No. 240/OP/88, dt. 27.2.1988, contrary to Notification vide Advt. No. 2/Services III Section/2010, dt. 27th September, 2010 and also violative of Article 14, 16 and 21 of Constitution of India and consequently direct the Respondents to consider the case of petitioner by duly conducting the recruitment to the post of Junior Assistant cum Typist as per rules in vogue.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased direct the Respondents to stay all further process of selection for appointment to the post of Junior Assistant cum Typist including issuance of appointment orders in pursuance of Notification vide Advt. No. 2/Services III Section/2010, dt. 27th September, 2010 in so far as Zone VII is concerned.
