ORDER:

This Contempt Case is filed by invoking the provisions under Section 10 to 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act to punish the respondents for non-implementation of the orders passed by this Court in W.P.No.24793 of 2012, dated 13.08.2012.

2. When the matter was taken up for hearing on 07.12.2023, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner. To give an opportunity, the matter was posted to 08.12.2023. On 08.12.2023 also there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner. To give a final opportunity, the matter is posted to 14.12.2023 under the caption "For Dismissal". Today also there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner inspite of listing the matter under the caption "For Dismissal."

3. Counter affidavit is filed by the respondent - Tahsildar, wherein it stated that pursuant to the orders passed by this Court in W.P.No.24793 of 2012, dated 13.08.2012, the respondents considered the application submitted by the petitioner and issued notice on 09.01.2013.

4. In view of the above, no further adjudication is required.

5. Accordingly, the Contempt Case is closed. However, the petitioner is granted liberty to avail the remedies as available under law.

Pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, shall stand closed.
