Petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioner in Crime 79/2023, and may be pleased to provide protection in the event of their arrest. The petitioner/accused also requests any other relief that this Hon'ble Court deems fit and just in the interest of justice.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri RAPOLU BHASKAR, Advocate for the Petitioner and the Public Prosecutor Telangana on behalf of the Respondent No.1 None Appeared for the Respondent No. 2

The Court made the following: ORDER

CRIMINAL PETITION No. 9687 of 2023

ORDER:

1. This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. by petitioner/Accused seeking bail in the event of his arrest in connection with Crime No.79 of 2023 on the file of Chinnagudur Police Station, Mahbubabad, registered for the offence punishable under Section 363 of IPC.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent-State and perused the record.
3. The allegation against this petitioner is that he has taken the victim girl who is less than 18 years forcibly to Hyderabad and committed rape on her in a Hotel.
4. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is falsely implicated and he is totally immobile.

5. However, on instructions, learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that evidence was collected, *prima facie*, the petitioner has taken the victim girl to a Hotel.

6. In view of the statement made by the victim girl, there are no grounds to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is dismissed. Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
