Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondent Nos.5 and 6 in interfering into the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petitioner's agriculture land in Sy.No.166/E/2 to an extent of Ac.0.37 gts which situated at Thippareddipalli Revenue Village, Vangoor Mandal, Nagarkurnool District, by colluding with the 7th respondent, and trying to dispossess the petitioner from his

above land, without issuing any notice to the petitioner, without following due process of law, and trying to change the land of the petitioner on the name of the 7th respondent, without following the due process of law is highly illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional, violation of Articles 14 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondent Nos.5 and 6 not to enter into the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petitioner's agriculture land in Sy.No.166/E/2 to an extent of Ac.0.37 gts which situated at Thippareddipalli Revenue Village, Vangoor Mandal, Nagarkurnool District, not to collude with the 7th respondent, not to dispossess the petitioner from her above land, to issue any notice to the petitioner, to follow due process of law, and not to change the land of the petitioner on the name of the 7th respondent.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent Nos.5 and 6 not to enter into the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petitioners agriculture land in Sy.No.166/E/2 to an extent of Ac.0.37 gts which situated at Thippareddipalli Revenue Village, Vangoor Mandal, Nagarkurnool District, not to collude with the 7th respondent, not to dispossess the petitioner from her above land, to issue any notice to the petitioner, to follow due process of law, and not to change the land of the petitioner on the name of the 7th respondent pending disposal of the writ petition.

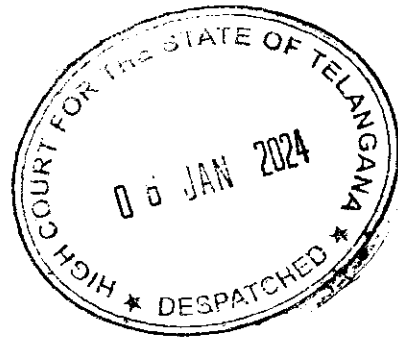
