This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure by the petitioner/accused No.4 to quash the proceedings against him in Crime No.154 of 2023 of Banjara Hills Police Station, Hyderabad, registered for offences punishable under Section 370, 370A(2) IPC and Sections 3, 4 and 5 of Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is allowed.

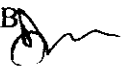
