We could see the merit behind the suggestion made by Sri B .Sudhakar Reddy, learned counsel for the 1st respondent – employee. But, however, the learned Government Pleader would urge that the Tribunal, in the meantime, is proceeding in a hurry with the Contempt Case initiated by the employee. Therefore, we stay the

proceedings of the Contempt Case initiated by the 1st respondent until further orders are passed in writ petition.

Post the writ petition for further consideration for admission on 06.10.2015.
