Crime No.382/2023 of Matwada Police Station, Warangal District.

Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri C Sharan
Reddy, Advocate for the Petitioner and the Public Prosecutor on behalf of the
Respondent.

The Court made the following: ORDER

THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE K.SURENDER

CRIMINAL PETITION No.10800 OF 2023

ORDER:

1. This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. by the petitioner/Accused seeking anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest in connection with F.I.R.No.382 of 2023 dated 29.09.2023 on the file of the Matwada Police Station, Warangal District, registered for the offences under Sections 406, 417, 420, 468 and 471 of Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC').

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent-State and perused the record.

3. On perusal of the record, since the punishment prescribed for the offences alleged against the petitioner is up to seven years, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the Investigating Officer in F.I.R.No.382 of 2023 on the file of the Matwada Police Station, Warangal District, to follow the procedure laid down under Section 41-A Cr.P.C and also the guidelines formulated by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar***¹ scrupulously. The petitioner shall co-operate with the

Investigating Officer by furnishing information and documents as sought in concluding the investigation.

4. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed off.

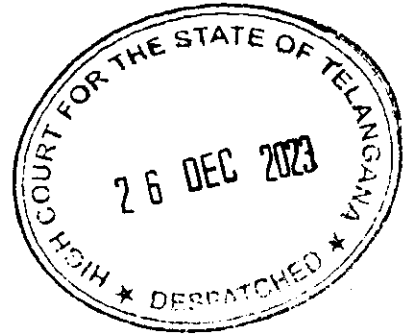
