ORDER:

Today when the matter has been taken up for hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the then Andhra Pradesh Administrative Tribunal, Hyderabad by order dated 30.09.2013, passed interim order as follows:-

"Pending disposal of the O.A., there shall be an interim suspension of the impugned proceedings No.1311/E/NTC/2013, dated 03.08.2013, issued by the 1st respondent to the extent of recovery."
