The Court made the following: ORDER

CRIMINAL PETITION No.11453 OF 2023

ORDER:

1. This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. by the petitioner/accused seeking to quash the proceedings against him in FIR No.1212 of 2023 dated 10.11.2023 on the file of the Medipally Police Station, Rachakonda, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 447, 427 and 506 of Indian Penal Code.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent-State and perused the record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that there were long pending civil disputes among the parties. In spite of an order in favour of the petitioner, respondent No.2 is trying to interfere with the property, for which reason, a complaint was lodged by the petitioner. However, police are taking sides and the complaint filed by the petitioner was refused to register.

4. Keeping in view that there are civil disputes between the parties, police shall conclude the investigation without taking coercive steps against the petitioner.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed off. Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.

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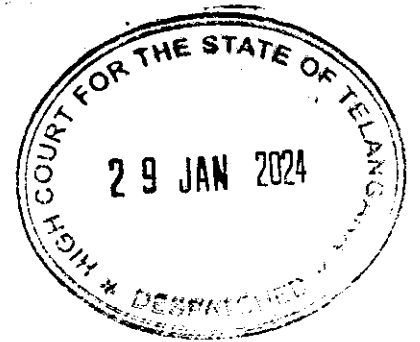
