Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the 3rd Respondent in not allotting the flats to the petitioners constructed by the Government in their Plots allotted to them by the 3rd Respondent vide Form-D Patta Certificates Nos. F/1857/95-S No.11 and F/1857 S.No.129 in Sy.No. TSI(P) B-B Ward, 8 and TSII(P) B-1 Ward 8 of Yousufguda, Golkonda, Hyderabad, as illegal, arbitrary null and void and consequently direct the 3rd respondent to handover our respective plots mentioned supra forthwith

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 3rd respondent to deliver the Flats to the Petitioners as per Form-D

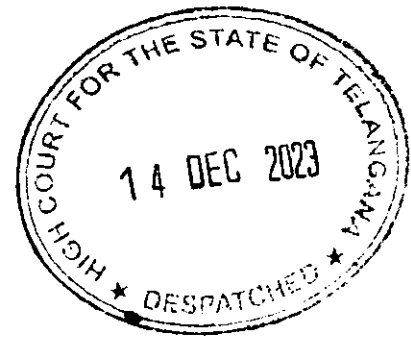
