No. CGM(HRD)/GM(Per)/AS(Per & Ser)/PO-A/39-A1/2018, dt.09.07.2018 and not considering the Petitioner for appointment for the post of Sub-Engineer (Electrical) with the Respondents as per the Notification No.01/2016, dated 03.01.2016 as arbitrary illegal and violative of Article 14, 19 and 21 of

Constitution of India and consequently direct the Respondents to appoint the Petitioner as Sub-Engineer (Electrical) with the Respondents.
