This Criminal Petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.'), is filed by the petitioner-accused No.3 to quash the proceedings against her in C.C.No.18 of 2017 on the file of learned Judicial First Class Magistrate at Narayanpet, Mahaboobnagar District, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 191, 192, 193, 196, 199, 200, 297, 420, 447 read with 120(B) of Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC')

2. None appears for the petitioner. Perused the record.
3. As seen from the proceeding sheet, earlier also there was no representation. The case is of the year 2017. The criminal petition was filed in the year 2018. No interim orders were passed by this Court when the case was filed in the year 2018. The exact stage in the trial Court is not known.
