WRIT PETITION No.34980 of 2023

ORDER:

This writ petition is filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, seeking the following relief:

"...to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondent Nos.3 to 4 in not conducting enquiry to include the names of the petitioners in the Social Economic Survey report to extend the R&R benefits like wages and house site pattas to the petitioners as per the order dated 14.03.2022 in Writ Petition No.14220 of 2020 by considering the petitioners' representation dated 14.11.2023 and also in pursuance of the proceedings in Rc.No.C20214/86/2022 dated 22.11.2022 of the respondent No.2 is illegal, arbitrary and contrary to law, apart from violation of principles of natural justice, besides violation of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents Nos.3 and 5 to consider the representation dated 14.11.2023 of the petitioners to include the names of the petitioners in the Social Economic Survey report to extend the R&R benefits like wages and house site pattas to the petitioners as per the order dated 14.03.2022 in Writ Petition No.14220 of 2020..."

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2. Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioners, and learned Government Pleader for Land Acquisition appearing for the respondent No.1, learned Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for the respondent Nos.2 to 4 and Sri P.Sri Harsha Reddy, learned Standing Counsel appearing for respondent No.5.

3. In view of the submissions made by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners, without going into merits of the case, this Writ Petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to dispose of the representation filed by the petitioners on 14.11.2023 by considering the orders passed by this Court dated 14.03.2022 in W.P.No.14220 of 2020, within eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs.

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4. Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.

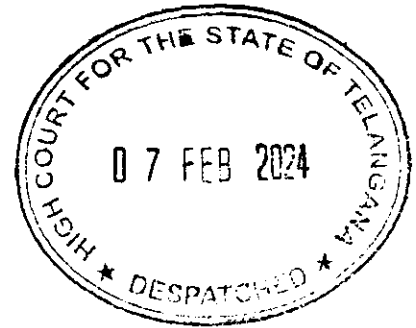
