This Criminal petition is filed seeking stay of all further proceedings against the petitioner/accused in Crime No.472 of 2014 on the file of Amberpet police station, Hyderabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that the subject crime of quashing has been investigated by the respondent-police and charge sheet under section 173 of Cr.P.C., has been filed in Cr.No.472 of 2014 on the file of Amberpet Police Station, Hyderabad and the matter has become infructuous. 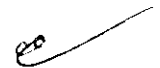
3. Mr. Vizarath Ali, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent-State is present and takes no objection to the same.

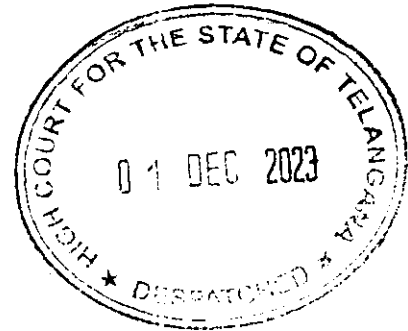
