Chief Metropolitan Magistrate at Nampally, Hyderabad, and to quash the same, and to grant such other relief or reliefs as this Honourable Court deems fit and Proper in the Circumstances to the case.

Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C Praying that in the Circumstances Stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further Proceedings including the appearance of the Petitioner in Connection with C.C.No. 650 of 2017 on the file of the VI Addl. ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioner/Accused, to quash the proceedings against him in CC.No.650 of 2017 on the file of VI Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate at Nampally, Hyderabad. The offences alleged against the petitioner are under Sections 354-D of the Indian Penal Code and Section 66(A), (b) of the Income-tax Act, 2008.

2. None appears for the petitioner.
3. The CC is of the year 2017. No interim order was granted by this Court when the case was filed in the year 2018. The stage of the CC before the trial Court is not known.
4. In the said circumstances, I do not find any reason to keep the petition pending. Accordingly, the criminal petition is disposed off granting liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court, if cause survives.

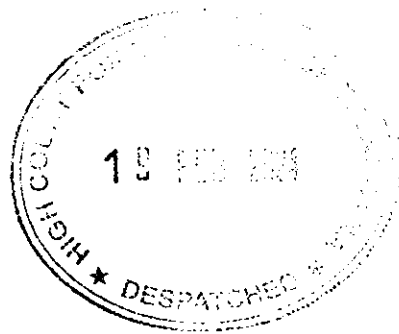
