Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the inaction of the 4th Respondent in implementation of the order of the 2nd Respondent Collector dated 3.11.2014 in file No.D1/2465/2012 to correct the records deleting the name of Sri T Ramesh in respect of land admn Ac 2.29 gts in S.No 332, Pudur Village and Mandal, Vikarabad District is void abinitio, illegal and against to the Article 14, 21 and 300A of the Constitution of India and consequently, allow the Writ petition by directing the Respondents to implement the order of the 2nd Respondent- Collector dated 3.11.2014 in file No. D1/2465/2012

ORDER:

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue.

2. This writ petition is filed seeking a writ of mandamus to declare the action of respondent No.4 in not implementing the orders passed by respondent No.2 in File No.D1/2465/2012, dated 03.11.2014, for correcting the entries in respect of the land admeasuring Acs.2.29 guntas in Survey No.332 of Pudur Village and Mandal, Vikarabad District, as illegal and arbitrary.

3. The proceedings, dated 03.11.2014, is an order passed by respondent No.2 in exercise of his jurisdiction under Section 9 of the Telangana Rights in Land and Pattadar Passbooks Act, 1971, wherein respondent No.2 set aside the proceedings in File No.B/11/2007, dated 12.01.2007, issued by respondent No.4 herein and further directed the respondent No.4 to cancel the entries if any made pursuant to the proceedings dated 12.01.2007.

4. According to learned counsel for the petitioner, the entries that were made pursuant to the proceedings dated 12.01.2007

have not been reversed till date in spite of specific orders issued by respondent No.2 as early as on 03.11.2014.

5. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, on instructions, submitted that after introduction of Dharani Portal, in order to implement the order dated 03.11.2014 passed by respondent No.2, the petitioner has to make an online application in Dharani Portal under TM- 33 Module and in case, if the petitioner makes such application, the same would be considered by the respondents in accordance with law.

6. In the light of the above facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is of the considered view that the writ petition can be disposed of at the admission stage and accordingly the writ petition is disposed of permitting the petitioner to submit an online application through Dharani Portal under TM - 33 Module requesting for implementation of the order dated 03.11.2014 passed by respondent No.2 in File No.D1/2465/2012 within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on submission of such online application, respondent Nos.2 and 4 shall consider the same and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law within a further period of six weeks from the date of submission of

online application by the petitioner. There shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous Petitions, if any, pending in this writ petition shall stand closed.
