Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Certiorari, calling for the records relating to issuance of Property Tax Demand Bill No. 080008116 dt. 31.5.2013 from the file of the 2nd Respondent in respect of the Petitioners property bearing D. No. 5-4-195/B/12, Abids (South) Hyderabad and after perusing the same, quash the said demand by declaring it as arbitrary, discriminatory, violative of principles of natural justice and contrary to law and consequently direct the Respondents to issue Property Tax Demand for the years 2012-13 and 2013-14, after issuing notice and giving opportunity to the Petitioner, under the provisions of Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation Act, and also declare that the Petitioner is not liable to pay the penalty and with all other consequential benefits.
