the 2nd respondent in entertaining O.P.No.23 of 2014 filed by the respondent no.5 herein is illegal, null and void and without jurisdiction, apart from violative of articles 14 and 19 of the Constitution of India and as well as principles of natural justice

ORDER:

This writ petition is filed seeking to declare the action of the respondent No.2 in entertaining O.P.No.23 of 2014 on the file of the Additional District Judge, Ranga Reddy District at Vikarabad filed by the respondent No.5 as illegal and arbitrary.

2. At the time of admission, no interim order was granted in the writ petition. As the tenure of the petitioner as Sarpanch was completed in the year 2018, the cause in the writ petition does not survive and the writ petition has become infructuous.

3. In view of the same, the Writ Petition is dismissed as infructuous.

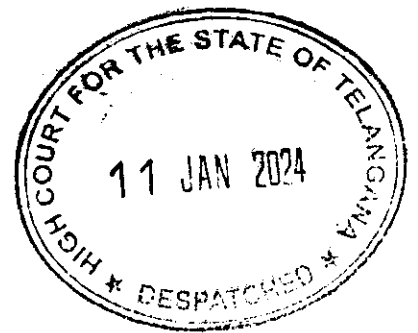
