Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction more particularly one in nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents in not extending the benefits of revised pay scale of 2015 issued by G.O. Ms. No. 25 Finance Department, dated 18/03/2015 to the members of the petitioner's society whose list is filed as ExP2 , is illegal, arbitrary and violative of principles of natural justice and Article 14, 16 and 21 of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the Respondents to extend the revised pay scale benefits of 2015 issued vide G.O. Ms. No. 25 Finance Department, dated 18/03/2015 to the eligible members of the petitioners society together with arrears of pay till date.
