closed.

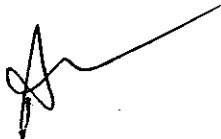

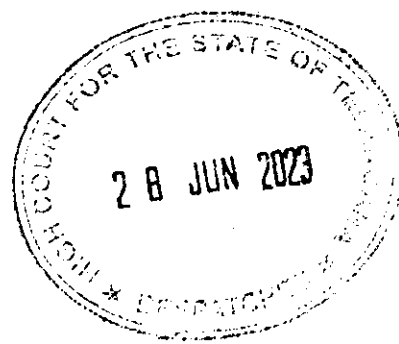
