ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed by the petitioner/accused under Section 438 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 seeking pre-arrest bail in Crime No.226 of 2020 of Station House Officer, Jeedimetla Police Station, Cyberabad, registered for the offences under Section and 420, 468, 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

02. Heard Sri Bendi Sai Santosh, learned counsel for the petitioner/accused as well as Sri T. V. Ramana Rao, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the Respondent / State and perused the record.

03. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has submitted that police have completed investigation and charge sheet is also filed in this case. The same is recorded. Once investigation is completed and charge sheet is filed, the petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C is not maintainable.

04. Accordingly, the criminal petition is dismissed granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge the charge sheet filed by the respondent/state. No costs.

As a sequel, pending Miscellaneous Applications in this matter, if any, shall stand closed.
