ORDER:

This Criminal Petition was filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short Cr.P.C.) to quash the proceedings against petitioner/accused No.3 in P.R.C.No.63 of 2015 on the file of the learned VII Metropolitan Magistrate, Hayathnagar, Rangareddy District for the offences under Sections 370(A)(2) of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short the IPC) and Section 3 and 4 of the P.I.T. Act.

2. The case was filed questioning the proceedings in P.R.C. No interim order was passed by this Court when the case is filed. In view of the same, I do not find any reason to keep the petition pending.
