ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed to quash the order dated 29.06.2015 passed by learned Chief Metropolitan Sessions Judge, Hyderabad in Criminal Revision Petition No.9 of 2015 and to direct the learned VIII Addl. Chief Metropolitan Magistrate to take cognizance of offence under Sections 120-B, 406, 420, 468 and 471 r/w 34 of IPC.
