ORDER:

This Criminal Petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.'), is filed by the petitioners-accused Nos.8 and 9 to quash the proceedings against them in C.C.No.204 of 2018 on the file of learned Junior Civil Judge, Bellampally, Mancherial District, registered for the offences under Sections 403, 406, 409, 420, 468, 471, 477(A), 411, 414 read with 120(B) of Indian Penal Code (for short 'I.P.C').

2. None appeared for the petitioners on 07.11.2023. As such, the case was posted to today under the caption for dismissal but today also there was no representation. No interim orders were passed by this Court when the case was filed earlier. The status in the trial Court is not known.

3. I do not find any reason to keep this Criminal Petition pending.

4. Accordingly, this Criminal Petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
